

A post office with walk-in freezers and mail delivery by mules! The Peach Springs post off ice right here in Arizona (near Kingman) uses the freezers to store food destined for delivery to the bottom of the Grand Canyon by mule train. Each mule carries about 130 pounds of mail, food, supplies and furniture down the 8-mile trail to the Havasupai Indians. The mule trains average 4,000 pounds per day.


And the #1 Surprisingly Best Sci-Fi Movies of Summer 2015 is...
